

Gator game guide

PRE-GAME

■ Two hours prior to kickoff, no traffic will be allowed on Gale Lemerand Drive from University Avenue to Stadium Road.

CAMPUS PARKING

- Decal restrictions are lifted.
- Free RV parking is available behind the Hilton UF Hotel & Conference Center Lot opens at 6 p.m. Friday and has shuttle service to the stadium starting two hours before kickoff.
- Reserved RV parking is in the large commuter lot, Pony Field lot, and triangle lot between Archer Road and 16th Avenue starting at 6 p.m. on Friday before the game.
- Disabled Parking starting this season will be Reserved at the O'Connell Center, Murphree Hall area and near Academic Advising. All those fans that do not qualify for Reserved Disabled parking should utilize Garage IX located on the south side of Archer Road on Gale Lemerand Dr. Shuttle service from Garage IX will begin 4 hours prior to kick-off. All buses are ADA accessible.

AVOID TRAFFIC WITH GATOR AIDER PARK & RIDE

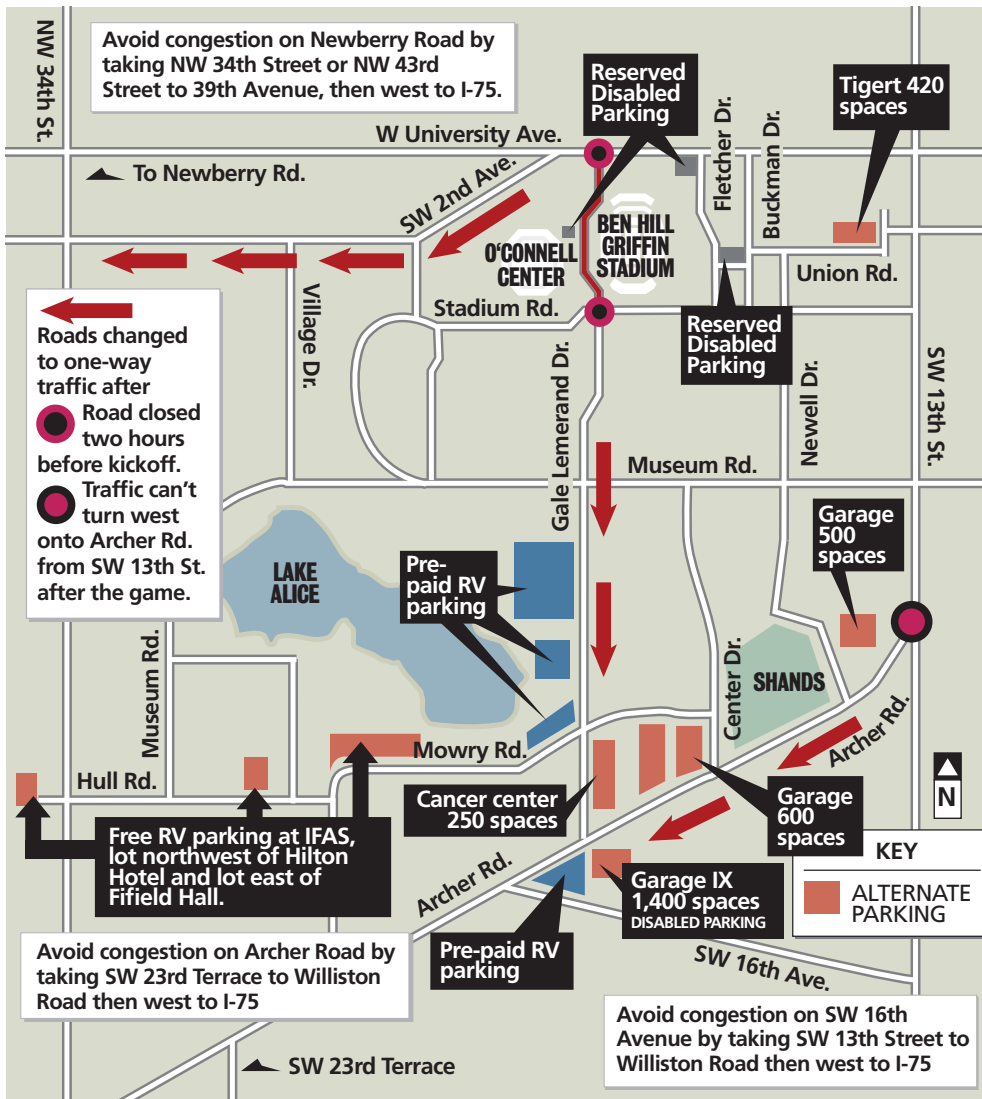
- R.T.S. provides shuttle service from The Oaks Mall, The Hilton UF Hotel and Conference Center, Haile Plantation at the Village Center, Tioga Town Center, and the SW Downtown Parking Garage (enter SW 3rd St. off University Ave. Buses load on the corner of SW 2 St. and SW 1 Ave.)
- Service begins three hours before kickoff with the last bus departing 10 minutes before kickoff. Return buses start at the 4th quarter mark and run throughout the first hour after the game ends.

DON'T SCALP TICKETS ON CAMPUS

■ The law prohibits any individual or organization from selling or purchasing tickets at any price on campus without written consent by the University of Florida.

PROHIBITED ITEMS IN STADIUM

- Smoking, tobacco, alcoholic beverages, weapons, chairbacks larger than a single seat, food/drink containers, bottles, cans, thermoses, ice bags, ice chests, artificial noise making devices, large cameras, flags, umbrellas, back packs, carry bags, video cameras/cases, strollers or any items deemed hazardous by game management personnel. Law enforcement officials have the right to inspect any item for the purpose of spectator safety
- Prohibited items must be returned to vehicles or disposed of before entering the stadium. There are no provisions to check items at gates.
- No standing on seats
- No seatbacks larger than a single seat (16").
